



CAA POLICY FOR THE PAYING OF GRANTS TO ARCHERS ATTENDING INTERNATIONAL SHOOT

Cheshire Archers who are selected to shoot for Great Britain at international events, which involve travelling to another country, may apply for a grant from CAA to help assist them with expenses that are incurred as a result.

This applies to both junior and Senior archers, of any bow discipline.

CAA is prepared to issue £50 up to 3 times in a year for events for which they are selected.

Archers who are selected to shoot for one of the UK Home Nations should also be allowed to apply for a grant but only if the event takes place outside of the UK.

Archers may also apply for grants from Northern Counties Archery Society.
