NOTES. 1. Shooting will be under FITA and GNAS rules.

Rule 8.1.1.1 . At longer distances arrows will be shot in ends of 6 arrows in 4 mins.

Rule 8.2.1.1. There will be 4 archers per boss shooting in 2 details

2. Archers must conform to GNAS dress regulations (Rule 307) i.e. Archers to wear green or white or their official club colours as notified to AGB.

3. To be eligible for the Champions Trophy, boys and girls must shoot the WA 1440 rounds.

4. Age on the date of tournament , please.

5. All entries should be signed by a club official or adult.

6. Record Status shoots are liable to drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

7. Late entries accepted only if space permits.

8. Anyone wishing to take photographs should advise the Tournament Organiser.

The tournament is open to juniors of all abilities and ages, from those using fibreglass bows to those using recurves and compounds.

There are prizes for the top Cheshire archer and top Visitor in each section, the best team (Cheshire and Visiting) and for the best scoring novice (archer who is shooting at their first tournament or archer shooting a fibreglass bow).

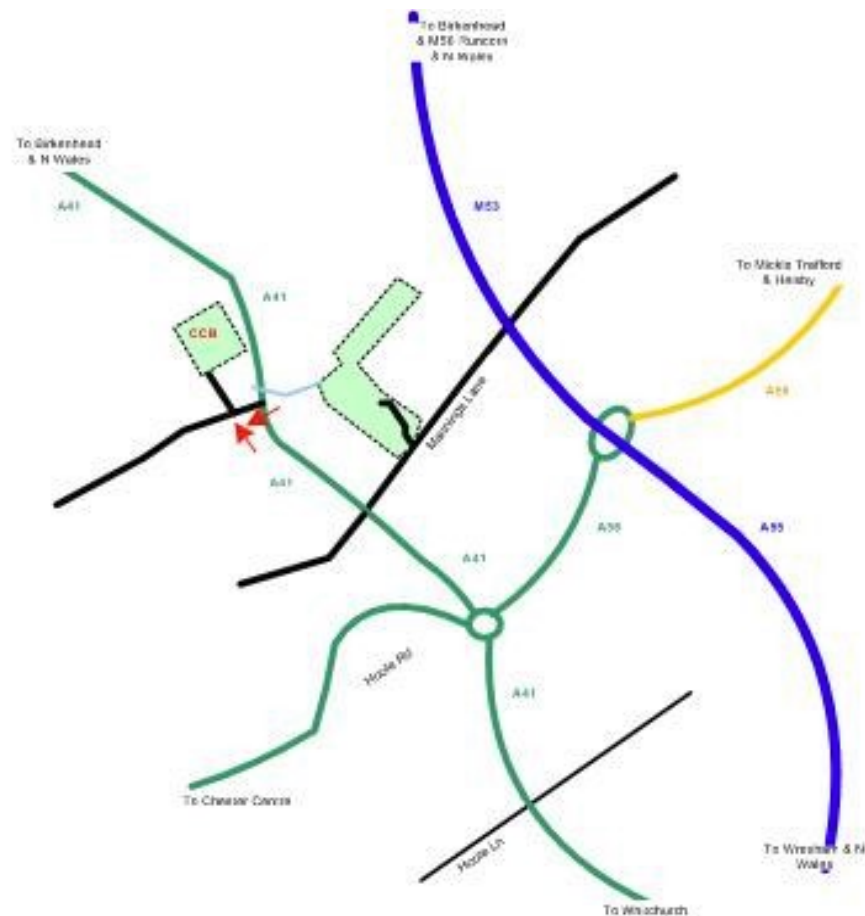
